Staff Permissions

- Permissions revamp group presented plan for new, broad proxies.
 - Most staff and librarians would be assigned to NDSTANDARD.
 - A small number of individuals (outside Systems) who need special access would be assigned to NDADVANCED.
 - Most students would be assigned to NDSTUDPUB or NDSTUDTECH. Additional student proxies would be created if needed, but it is not recommended for students to be assigned to staff proxies.
 - Budget access is defined separately from the functional proxies. Those who need full budget access would be assigned to NDADVBUDGE.
- Cataloging Levels
 - There have been some issues with cataloging levels. Past policy was to use 20 for all individuals with catalog access, but we recently found IDs with 01, 02, 30 and 40.
 - Systems has cleaned up ND userIDs to have only 00 or 20, and has verified that there are no current bib records with other levels.
 - Discussed possibility of a fix routine to force all records to level 20 when saved.
 - Discussed possibility of making everyone level 99.
 - Decided to use levels 00 (non-catalogers) and 99 (catalogers) going forward.

 - Testing begins: Tuesday, May 29
 - Implement in Prod: June 8
- SP will be implemented on Paul
- SP will be linked on the wiki ([ALEPH-20.2-ServicePack-6.xls](#): Aleph Release Notes 20.2 Service Pack 6)
- Be sure to test FYEC with the SP. Problems with FYEC would be a reason to delay production implementation to July.
- Question: Does this require repackaging the client?
