# **Evolved Developmental Niche-History (EDNH)**

# For age 18 and older

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<u>Note to researchers</u>: This questionnaire involves questions that refer to the Evolved Developmental Niche (EDN), the parenting practices that evolved to match up with the maturational schedule of the young child (Hewlett & Lamb, 2005; Konner, 2010; Narvaez, Panksepp et al., 2013).

There is evidence that the EDN influences child wellbeing and morality (Narvaez, Gleason et al., 2013; Narvaez, Wang et al., 2013). The experiences that are captured by the EDN metric include positive and negative social experiences that are present in the caregiver-child relationships as well as larger social environment. These relational patterns are often carried forward through childhood and consequently, adults are asked to reflect on and report on the sum of their childhood experience.

Our studies with adults and college students (e.g., Narvaez, Wang & Cheng, 2016; n=607) show that scores on this measure (EDN-H) is related to and predictive in path models linking attachment, mental health, social capacities and moral orientation (higher EDN relates to compassionate morality and its precursors; lower EDN relates to self-protective morality and its precursors).
