Meet Greg Crawford, dean of the College of Science at the University of Notre Dame to learn about Notre Dame's role in the fight against Niemann-Pick Type C disease.

Since 2010, Greg Crawford, dean of the College of Science, has dedicated his summers to cycling across the country to raising awareness and funds for research to find treatments or a cure for Niemann-Pick Type C (NPC) disease---A rare, genetic cholesterol-storage disorder that is always fatal and took the lives of three grandchildren of legendary Notre Dame football coach Ara Parseghian.

Greg has biked a total of 11,224 miles, held events with over 60 Notre Dame alumni clubs, visited over 120 cities, organized several campus fund raisers with Notre Dame athletics teams, and educated millions of people about NPC through media interviews, blogs, and other promotional materials.

Expanding his fundraisers efforts, Greg will embark upon his final cross-country bike ride to bring awareness and raise \$1 million for NPC and all rare disease research at Notre Dame's Boler-Parseghian Center for Rare and Neglected Diseases. In May 2015, his journey will take him from Long Island, N.Y. to Pebble Beach, CA, from May 26-June 26. He will be passing through our area on May 31 and would love to spend the evening with our clubs.
