- Start early!
- Start early!
- The power of the group.
  - Read the whole homework before you start anything.
    - Ask for clarifications.
  - Walk through and come up with a plan.
  - Review documentation together.
  - Start together (For example, get one development environment working, then replicate).
- USE office hours.
- Installation was a pain (I felt it too, kinda).
  - Know who you are.
    - Know when to use root and when not to.
    - Don't run 'similar' commands as both root and non-root user.
    - Be consistent.
  - Know where you are.
    - Remember to activate virtual environment.
    - Production or Development environment.
    - /opt or /home/username
  - Understand what you are doing.
    - Don't just copy/paste commands.
  - Use the right version.
    - Remember: LTS, Stable.
