Archives! will provide a solid introduction to doing research in archives. Participants will receive an introduction to archival theory and terminology, get tips for planning a research trip, and learn the essentials for how to use an archive. In addition, participants will spend the majority of time gaining experience working with letter collections, diaries, ledgers, memoirs, and visual collections.

Hands-on experience is the best way to prepare for an archival research trip. *Archives!* will give you just that. Practice reading and transcribing different hands. Learn to identify paper types, watermarks, and other distinguishing characteristics. Learn what types of questions to ask about the various materials and what types of information lay hidden in them. Learn how to read and analyze images.
