Please answer these questions **BEFORE** reading **Chapter 11!** There are no right or wrong answers, I just want you to explore what you know and what you think you know before reading the text.

1. What is your name?
2. How do you think genus *Homo* will be different from the Australopithecines we have been looking at?
3. Do you think we will see the same high degree of variation in early *Homo* that we saw with Australopithecines? Why or why not?
4. What cultural changes do you think came about with genus *Homo*? How do you think those cultural changes may impact the anatomy we see in the fossils?
