

Moeschberger, Ordonez, Shankar, and Raney (2006) created a non-linear model addressing the development of social justice interest and commitment. An individual (a) has contact with the reality of oppression and conflict, (b) develops an increased awareness of social injustice, (c) formulates a sense of efficacy to bring about change, (d) understands her or his role in relation to this change, (e) develops a deeper understanding of the sociopolitical context of social issues, and (f) engages in advocacy to bring about change.
