Kylemore Abbey

Kylemore Abbey's foundation stone was laid on September 4, 1867 by Margaret Vaughan Henry, the wife of Mitchell Henry. The estate had been bought and planned as an elaborate love token for Margaret and as a 'nesting place' for the growing Henry family. Although Mitchell Henry was born in Manchester, he proudly proclaimed that every drop of blood that ran in his veins was Irish. It was to Ireland that he brought Margaret on honeymoon in the mid-1840s and where they first saw the hunting lodge in the valley of Kylemore that would eventually become their magnificent home.

If for any reason you shall arrive after or before opening times of 'Kylemore Abbey' (10am-5:00pm) please let us know as the main gate could be closed & we will need to forward you a code for it & make sure the visitor gate is also open for your arrival.

Continue to make your way to the Notre Dame Global Centre located to the right of Abbey (using the upper main pedestrian road), once passed the Abbey you will see a 'Private' sign on a wooden gate, open it (then close) and follow the path along the centre to our reception. Notre Dame Global Centre.

There will be someone at the centre to greet you and give you your lanyard and room key.

In case you have a mobility issue or heavy items to carry, please let us know beforehand for us to organise transportation to our centre, as the Kylemore Abbey 'staff' ARE NOT responsible to sort out those possible issues.

Please do not arrive at the centre before check-in time as your room may not be ready.
